 - c. At least three pieces of quoted or paraphrased evidence from *Life of Pi* in each body paragraph to pair with the cited research.
 - d. All sources tracked on NoodleTools
- 2. <u>Submission of thesis and one body paragraph for feedback by its due date or you might not receive feedback</u>
- 3. Printed rough draft
- 4. Printed final essay with a cover page and a works cited page
