General Supplies Needed in Seventh Grade*:

- iPad and charger (brought to school every day, fully charged); all classes use them
- earbuds or headphones to use with the iPad (frequently used, *preferably with a mic*, no loaners this year)
- reliable stylus to use with iPad
- lots of pencils with erasers (if mechanical, make sure to have replacement lead)
- several pens of various colors
- colored pencils (these do not need to be a new pack - you will need at least 8 colors for use in Art, English, Math, Social Studies, and World Language)
- several highlighters of various colors
- hole punched loose white-lined paper (please avoid bound notebooks)

*Please check supplies quarterly to help your child restock; especially paper, pencils, etc.

Subject Specific Supplies Needed in Seventh Grade:

English - Mrs. Snow

- A two-pocket folder with clasps that can hold three-hole-punched notebook paper
- Highlighters or colored pencils of at least three different colors (referenced under general supplies)

Social Studies - Mrs. Dyer

- A two-pocket folder with clasps that can hold three-hole-punched notebook paper
- Two ultra-fine black Sharpies, or black Sharpie "Pens", for labeling maps

Science - Mr. Holt

- A two-pocket folder with clasps that can hold three-hole-punched notebook paper

Math - Mrs. Nolan

- A two-pocket folder with clasps that can hold three-hole-punched notebook paper
- LOTS of Pencils with erasers! Traditional wooden ones are best!

French - tbd

A three-ring binder (1-1 ½”) with some filler paper and three pocket dividers (if you want a larger one then you can get that instead!)

- Two pocket folder to either place inside of your binder or keep out (this will help organize papers)
- Colored pens and pencils for self-correcting and drawing

Spanish - Mr. Burokas

- A 1 to 1 ½ inch three-ring binder
- White lined paper
- 6 dividers with labels
- 3 hole paper adhesive reinforcers
- Headphones (ideally with a mic)
- Pencils and correcting pens

Health - Miss Steed

- A two-pocket folder

Physical Education - Mr. Wachtelhausen

- Bring appropriate footwear to every class
- Apple Watch, Fitbit, Garmin, etc. are **not mandatory** but encouraged and allowed to use/wear if students own

Digital Literacy - Mrs. Bassage & Mrs. Vasel

- iPad must be charged, headphones/earbuds with microphone MUST come to every class
- You must have a pencil or pen for each class

Art - Mrs. Pierron

- You must have a pencil for each class
- Sketchbook is not required but very welcome (no sketch pads please)

Band - Miss Trainor

- A working instrument must be brought to every class
- Extra parts if necessary (reeds, valve oil, cork grease, slide grease, drumsticks, etc.)

Chorus - Mrs. Rutkiewicz, Mr. Hunt

- A durable two-pocket folder with your name on the outside front cover...this will remain in the chorus room, in your assigned slot
- Pencil - this can live in your folder (mechanical suggested)

Theatre - Mrs. Rutkiewicz (no specific supplies needed)
