Forms & Permissions

During the first week of school, we will send home forms that require Parent/Caregiver signatures. Please ensure these forms are checked over for accuracy, signed and returned to the school as soon as possible.

School Supply Fees

Heffley Creek Elementary offers and strongly encourages a user fee program for school supplies with payment through School Cash Online. For a nominal fee, we supply all pens, pencils, exercise books, crayons etc.

Money

Please do not send money to the school with your child unless there has been a written request from the teacher. Our school offers [SchoolCash Online](#), which provides you with the convenience of paying online for school items such as field trips, school supply fees, etc. This is the preferred way for families to pay for school-related items.

Emergency Preparedness Drills

All schools participate in Emergency Preparedness Drills each year. We will have six fire drills, two lockdown practices and an Earthquake drill. If your child talks to you about these drills, please reassure them that the practices are to ensure their safety in an emergency.

Scent Considerate Environment

For most of us, perfumes, essential oils and colognes add an element of enjoyment to our lives. However, scent allergies are on the rise and we have district staff members who are severely allergic to scents. For them, being around scents results in difficulties breathing, migraines/headaches, sneezing and feeling unwell. Please help us to keep the school environment free of scents by not using scents before visiting and ensuring that your child(ren) are not wearing scented products.

On Call Lunch Hour Supervisors Needed

We are in need of parents to help with lunch supervision. This on call role helps to provide a safe lunch hour experience for students and is a huge help to our staff team. This involves supervision from 12:00-1:00 pm, comes with a \$20 honorarium and provides an opportunity to connect with our school community. Patience and a Criminal Record Check on file are needed. Criminal Record Checks for Volunteers

All volunteers who wish to be involved in field trips and other school based activities are required to submit a criminal record check. Once completed, criminal record checks are valid for three years within SD 73 schools. All Criminal Record Checks must be completed through the online [Criminal Record Check Review](#) program. For the sake of streamlining information, the Criminal Record Checks for Heffley Creek and Rayleigh Elementary are all handled through the Rayleigh Elementary School website and can be used for both schools (if your child has older siblings and/or moves there in Grade 4). We encourage anyone interested in volunteering to proactively complete this process as soon as possible.

Dress Code

While at school, students are expected to dress in a way that aligns with the learning environment that they are in. Heffley Creek Elementary follows the SD73 Dress Code and this includes choosing clothing that avoids the following things:

- promoting the use of tobacco, illegal drugs or alcohol
- advocating for illegal activity
- promoting hatred of a person or persons, including, but not limited to, clothing that denigrates or promotes hate based on race, colour, ancestry, place of origin, religion, marital status, family status, physical or mental disability, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity and/or expression, or age
- containing profanity, pornography or obscene images

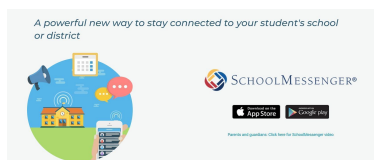
Medical Alerts & Admin. of Medication

Please remember that it is a family's responsibility to let the school know if your child has a serious health condition or requires medication while at school. School district personnel are not permitted to administer medication to students unless specifically authorized to do so by a Doctor. Please ensure you obtain the forms from the office that authorizes the school to administer a prescription or identify the steps to take in a medical emergency. These forms need to be renewed each school year.



Student Absences

Parents/Caregivers are encouraged to no longer leave a message on the school's answering machine. Our system handles the majority of parent/caregiver contact (including phone calls) for current and upcoming student absences. If your child arrives late or needs to leave part way through the day, they **must** be signed in or out at the office.

Personal Digital Devices

Heffley Creek Elementary School's personal digital devices guidelines & expectations are guided by the Provincial Government and SD73 and have been developed with staff and parents/caregivers to promote online safety and focused learning environments for all students. If students wear Smart watches and devices of this nature, they need to be in **"Do Not Disturb"** mode from 8:30-2:34

During Instructional Time (class time & field trips), student use of personal digital devices is only permitted based on staff discretion. Students are encouraged to not bring personal electronic devices to school. Any use of personal digital devices must comply with [Administrative Procedure 145: Use of Personal Electronic Devices](#).
