Credit Union Place (Summerside)- Most games will be played on the Ice Pad

- It is strongly recommended that masks be worn by participants from the entrance to the facility to the dressing rooms, in the halls when tying skates, and from the dressing room to the exit after the ice time.
- For games on the Ice Pad, participants will use Gate 2, the visiting spectators will use entrance 1 (Side B), and home spectators will use Entrance 2 (Side A).
- We ask that a participant list (players & bench staff) be provided to the home team manager 24hrs prior to games, so this information can be passed onto the Credit Union Place. This will help expedite entrance to the facility as the Gate 2 entrance will be manned by Credit Union Place staff.

Other Facilities:

Simmons Sports Arena (Charlottetown)

- Simmons Sport Centre can have 50 spectators in the stands during games, up to 50 on the ice, and up to 50 in the dressing rooms preparing for the next game

Three Rivers Sportsplex (Georgetown)

- Approved for 50 spectators per team .Which will be split into two sections upon arrival. So for games two separate groups of 50 max.
- For a practice two parents per player to a max of 50.
- There is one entrance and two separate exits, one on the east and one on the west. Signage is provided but for clarity spectators in stands will exit to the side door facing parking lot.
- Spectators upstairs will exit using the side door at the opposite side.
- No travelling back through the main entrance area permitted. Both sections have their own set of bathrooms.
- 15 players per dressing room so if two dressing rooms are required for number purposes please give advance notice.
- Players are permitted to enter 20 minutes prior to ice time and leave 15 minutes after.
- Spectators are permitted to enter when ice time begins not before. Once you are in, face masks are mandatory.

Northumberland Arena (Murray River)

- Masks are mandatory
- 1 Spectator per player
- All visitors must wait to enter the facility until all the players are on the ice surface.
- Visitors must exit the facility as soon as the buzzer goes.

Pownal Sports Centre

Gateway Arena (Borden)

- The maximum capacity of the arena is 50. This number includes all players, team staff, workers, and officials.

- Teams/players are asked to exit the arena in a quick, timely manner following their ice time within a 15 minute time frame to allow the next group to enter with minimal contact.
- Arrive no earlier than 20-25 minutes before your scheduled ice rental.
- Teams/groups 13 years of age and under will be required to come dressed in their equipment to the arena for their scheduled ice time, they may use the dressing rooms to put on their skates, helmets and gloves but masks will be required while doing so.
- Teams/groups 14 years of age and older will have access to the dressing rooms to get ready however masks will be mandatory
- When your ice time is over please exit the arena in a quick/timely fashion.
- Anyone using the dressing rooms must exit using the side exit by room
- The front doors will only be used as an entrance.
- Anyone in the bleachers must use the exit to the side parking lot.

Belfast Rec Centre

- Can host up to three cohorts of 50 people in the facility at one time. This includes:
 - 1. On-ice cohort
 - 2. Spectator cohort
 - 3. Incoming teams cohort
- Players arriving
 - All players must wear masks and will enter through the main entrance
 - U10 and below players are recommended to come dressed and can enter the facility 20 minutes before their ice time
 - U12 and up can arrive 20 minutes before their ice time and are recommended to come with their bottom gear on
 - Dressing rooms will be available
 - Must sign in with their team covid liaison
 - Players must stay in their dressing room until the zamboni is off the ice
- Coaches and Team Liaison Arriving
 - Must wear masks and will arrive 5 minutes prior to the players to set up to complete contact tracing
 - Coaches will ensure players don't leave the dressing room before they are supposed to
- Parents/Spectators arriving

- All spectators must wear masks in the facility at all times
- U10 and below, parents can enter with the player for practices. For games they must follow the guidelines below
- U12 and up parents will enter through the main entry at the scheduled player's ice time
- Exiting
 - Parents/spectators will exit the facility as soon as the ice time is over
 - All players must exit the rink within 10 minutes of exiting the ice surface
 - All parents/spectators viewing from around the glass will leave the rink through the back rink entrance
 - All parents/spectators viewing from the 2nd level will exit through the 2nd level emergency exit that leads to the Sinclair MacTavish room and out the main entrance
 - All players in dressing rooms 1, 2, and 3 will exit through the back entrance
 - All players in dressing rooms 4, 5, and 6 will exit through the emergency exit on the 2nd floor and through the Sinclair MacTavish room and out the main entrance.
