

## Setting up your google slideshow-

You will need a **google account** – to start one follow the instructions on google

You will need to sign into your google account (not your old school account then go to

[www.sites.google.com/view/othc-art/home](http://www.sites.google.com/view/othc-art/home)

- Year 9
- Go to [Art Workbook Online](#) (Click the linked text beside the image of the workbook)
- Go to File
- Make a copy- entire presentation
- Go to upper right side of window and Share
- Change the link – to editor (not viewer)
- Copy the link
- Send to tkimiangatau@onetreehillcollege.school.nz
- Put your name in the subject line of the email
- Paste the copied link (from your share /copy link) into the comment part of the email (Ctrl V)
- **Setting up Pinterest:** (you will need this for reference imagery) Create a Pinterest account / sign in with google
- Click on your avatar or logo in top right then go to the internet address bar and copy address.
- **Go to slide 2 of your Google Slideshow and click hyperlink and follow both OTHC Art and Mr. Kimi**
- **Paste your Pinterest url onto slide 2,**
- Create a board called Art2024
- Pin images of your cultural patterns, your whanau plant and things that interest you onto that board (at least 10 images.)
