

CalTemp — Privacy Policy

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Overview

CalTemp ("the Extension") is a Chrome extension that allows users to create and manage event templates for Google Calendar. Your privacy is important to us. This policy explains what data the Extension accesses, how it is used, and how it is stored.

Data Collection and Use

Data stored locally

CalTemp stores the following data locally on your device using Chrome's built-in storage (chrome.storage.local):

- Event templates you create (titles, durations, categories, descriptions, locations, and guest email addresses)
- Your custom categories and preferences
- A cached list of your Google Calendar names and IDs

This data never leaves your device and is not transmitted to any external server.

Data accessed via Google Calendar API

When you choose to connect your Google account, CalTemp uses the Google Calendar API to:

- Retrieve your list of calendars (names, IDs, and colors)

This data is used solely to let you assign templates to specific calendars. CalTemp does not read, modify, or delete your calendar events through the API.

Authentication

CalTemp uses Google's OAuth 2.0 authentication (via Chrome's identity API) to securely access your Google Calendar data. Your authentication tokens are managed by Chrome and stored locally. CalTemp does not have access to your Google password.

Data Sharing

CalTemp does **not**:

- Sell or transfer your data to third parties
- Use your data for advertising or marketing purposes
- Use your data for purposes unrelated to the Extension's functionality
- Use your data to determine creditworthiness or for lending purposes
- Collect analytics or tracking data

Data Retention

All data is stored locally on your device. You can delete all Extension data at any time by:

- Removing templates and categories within the Extension's settings
- Signing out of your Google account within the Extension
- Uninstalling the Extension (which removes all locally stored data)

Third-Party Services

The only third-party service CalTemp communicates with is the Google Calendar API, governed by [Google's Privacy Policy](#).
