A. Yes, the camp cost is subsided by QATA for members


Q. Can I choose to attend for just one day?

A.Yes! You can share. Please let us know your preference for sharing and who you are sharing with in the notes section in Humanitix. The sharing options are below:

- a queen bed with a friend/ partner
- Unit 1 4 with a friend (1 person in the Queen and another on the sofa bed
- Unit 1-4 with two friends (2 people in the Queen bed and another on the sofa bed)
- Unit 5 with 4 Friends (2 in the Queen bed and 2 people in the singles)



Q. Can I organise my own accommodation?

Buses meet all ferry services though if you wish to transfer to Point Lookout via bus. There is a bus stop directly out the front of the house at 76 Mooloomba Road Point Lookout.


