English Settlement Expands to Thirteen Colonies

- *Setting:* In 1607, the only English colonists in North America were in Jamestown, where they faced serious challenges to their survival: a harsh environment, food shortages, internal disputes, disease, and threats from Native American tribes.

The New England, Middle, and Southern colonies were founded for different reasons and developed distinct ways of life, but all were well established and growing. Self-government was also thriving in the English colonies.
