

Desired behavior/experience:

Minimum:

- Users can use Database search or simple search to find databases by title
- All databases UCSC has access to have a Primo record and include an access link in the Primo record
- Entities that the library (and our users) consider to be databases are findable in the Database search and are labeled “Database” in Primo

Optimal:

- Users only see the records for the databases we have access to (databases cannot be ILL'd - so there is no reason for us to show them to users)

Tickets/Issues Seen:

- Database record in Primo does not display an access link for UCSC users even though UCSC has access
 - Last seen with the Index of Medieval Art (previously seen with BioCyc, just found an issue with ChemIDplus & ToxNet)
 - Brought to our attention by a patron seeking access
 - Our eResources librarian reported this to CDL and a link was added
