Footnotes is committed to respecting and protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you use our mobile application. Please read this policy carefully. By using Footnotes, you consent to this Privacy Policy.

Information We Collect

Personal Information:

We do not collect personal information unless explicitly provided by you. Personal information may include:

- Email address (if you contact support or opt-in for communications).

Location and Motion Data:

Footnotes uses location and motion data to record and display your walks. Your precise location data is collected only when the app is active and recording a walk.

Text Notes:

Any notes you enter into the app are stored locally on your device and synced securely with iCloud if enabled. We do not have access to your notes.

Usage Data:

Footnotes does not collect, track, or store any usage data, crash reports, interaction statistics, or performance metrics. All activities and data remain solely on your device.

How We Use Information

- Provide core functionality (record and display your walks and notes).
- Respond to your support requests if you reach out to us.

Sharing Your Information

We do NOT sell, trade, or rent your information to third parties. Footnotes does not share your location data, notes, or any personally identifiable information with external parties except as required by law or as necessary to comply with legal processes.

Data Security

Footnotes stores your data locally on your device and securely syncs with iCloud when enabled. We take appropriate security measures to protect your information but cannot guarantee absolute security.

Your Choices

You can:

- Turn off location tracking at any time in your device settings.
- Delete notes directly within the app.
- Delete the app from your device, which removes locally stored data.

Children's Privacy

Footnotes does not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If we become aware that we have inadvertently received personal information from a child under 13, we will delete such information promptly.
