

CCGC Sunday Service Attendee Guidelines

Phase I

General Protocols

- We are implementing a temperature check before entering the sanctuary
 - Line up outside the two sanctuary entrance doors (one on each side)
 - Your entrance will depend on your assigned seating location
 - Stay six feet behind the person(s) in front of you if they are not part of your household
 - Markers on the floor will help guide your distance
- Wash hands or use hand sanitizer upon entering the building
- For your health and safety, we recommend the following to please consider staying home and joining our livestream worship service:
 - 65 years old or older (if not fully vaccinated)
 - Those with serious underlying medical conditions (please discuss with your personal physician)
 - Those who would not be able to wear a mask for an extended period of time
- Please stay home if any attendee has any of the following symptoms:
 - Fever (99.5°F or 37.5°C) or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
 - If you have been in direct contact with someone who has tested positive for less than 2 weeks.
 - If you start exhibiting symptoms during the service, please excuse yourself and leave the campus respectfully for the sake of everyone else.

Face Masks

- Face masks must be worn at all times
- Face masks must cover both nose and mouth
- It is recommended to avoid touching your mouth, nose, and eyes, and other surfaces
- It is required that attendees bring their own face masks, but the church will provide one as needed
- Especially while inside the sanctuary, it is imperative to keep your face mask on
 - Ushers will check to make sure your face covering is adequate
 - If you do not feel comfortable singing, you can alternatively hum or stay silent
 - The only exception is when taking communion
- Face masks restrictions (we reserve the right to provide you with a proper masks if your mask is inadequate)
 - Face masks are still required if you are wearing face shield
 - Face masks with valves are not allowed

Specified Traffic

- Entering/Exiting the Sanctuary
 - Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the service
 - There will be 2 entrances and 2 exits
 - Please wait patiently after the service as you will be dismissed row by row by an usher
 - As you exit, please ensure 6 feet of space between you and the person in front of you
 - As much as possible, avoid crossing paths between entering/exiting

Sanctuary Seating

- Please RSVP everyone in your party who will attend the service via [link to be attached here]
 - You will have the ability to choose your assigned seating when you RSVP
- Please DO NOT sit in the sections that you are not assigned to
- Please keep social distance (6 ft) and do not shake hands with anyone outside of your household
- Cry Room is NOT available (it will only be used by worship service team members)

Restrooms

- All church campus restrooms will be open for use
- However, we recommend that you use the restroom at home prior to arriving at church to keep the foot traffic at a minimum
- Up to two people may use each restroom at a time
 - If there are already two people in the restroom, please wait outside the restroom until it is vacant before entering or try to use a different restroom
- Please keep masks on in the restroom
- Please follow hand-washing guidelines posted in the restrooms
