

**Template and Guidelines for Extended Abstract (Insert Title here;

These guidelines have been prepared in the format that should be used for your extended abstract. This file must be used as a template for the above said purpose. The word limit of the extended document is 1000. The font style for the entire extended abstract is Calibri and the font sizes for title, heading and body are 16, 14 and 12 respectively. Only the title and headings shall be in bold. Abstracts should be unstructured, however it must clearly cover the Background, Methodology, Results, and Conclusion. A maximum of 2 figures are allowed to be included in the extended abstract. Figures must be high-resolution and self-explanatory. Kindly note that it is NOT COMPULSORY to include figures in the Extended Abstract. Tables should be avoided, but data may be represented in the form of a figure as shown in Fig 2. Captions must be included at the bottom of each figure within the figure file 7. Figures must be high-resolution and self-explanatory. All accepted extended abstracts will be published in a special issue of “Frontiers In Education”.

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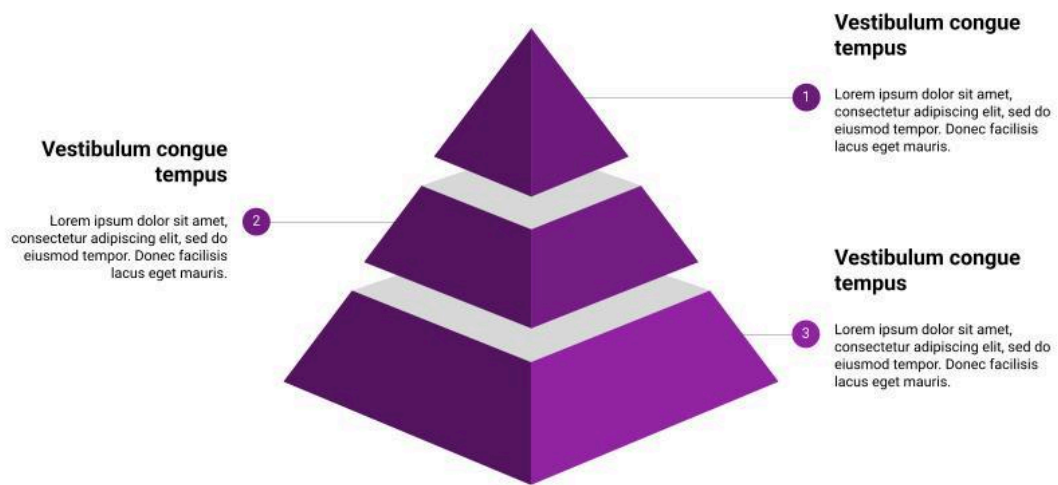


Fig 1: Title of the figure with captions

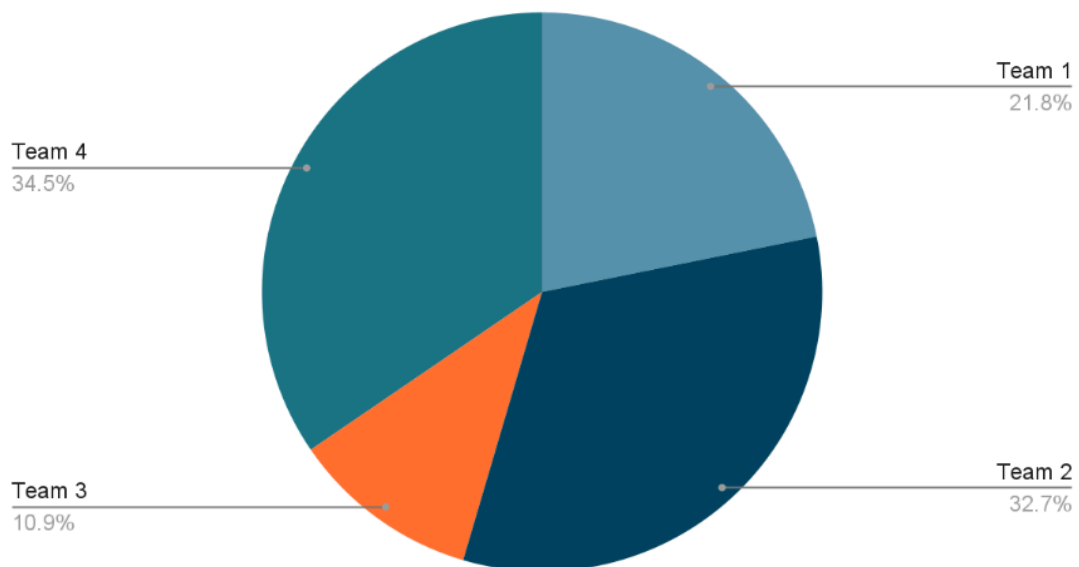


Fig 2: Title of the figure with captions
