Subject Areas include: Language and Literature (ELA), Mathematics, Sciences, Individuals and Societies (Social Studies), Language Acquisition (Foreign Language), Arts (any Visual or Performing Arts), Health and Nutrition, and Design (STEAM, Business Foundations and Fundamentals of Technology, Debate, Multimedia, or Desktop Publishing)

6th Grade Year 1:

- * 6th grade electives will be based on schedule availability and class size availability.
- * 6th grade electives are OPEN because of the semester-long MYP classes.
- * It is **HIGHLY ENCOURAGED** that a student wanting to take **band or orchestra** as their "arts credit" would join in the 6th grade due to contest regulations and expectations.

7th Grade Year 2:

7th grade electives **may begin at the beginning level of the arts/design area, but there may be times when a student moves into the intermediate level in 7th grade on a case by case basis. If a student has taken a beginning level in 6th grade, they may have the opportunity to take the intermediate level as a 7th grade MYP student.

8th Grade Year 3:

***8th grade elective levels will be based on what they took in 6th or 7th grade. For example, if a student took beginning art in 7th grade and wanted to continue in visual arts, they would take intermediate art. If they wanted to take a different elective area, they would begin at the beginning level (unless a teacher recommends otherwise).
