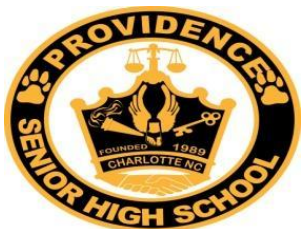

CPCC Career and College Promise (Dual Enrollment) **

Students must also submit an application to Lisa Hall, PHS Career Counselor, and follow the steps to successfully enroll in CPCC courses. Only students who complete the application process will have the courses added to their Providence schedule/transcript. Rising 12th graders can request up to four "CPCC Holds" on their schedules for CPCC courses to be added during the school year (two per semester). 12th graders who do not complete the required steps will have the holds removed and PHS courses added to their schedules.
