Panel sessions will be provided a 120-minute time slot to ensure comprehensive exploration and discussion of their proposed topic. Organizers have the flexibility to determine the number of presenters and the flow and structure of the panel as long as they follow the guidelines. Proposed panel sessions must comply with the theme.

The recommended structure for panel presentations is:

- Introduction and backgrounder by the panel organizer: 5 minutes
- 4-5 presentations: either 15 minutes or 20 minutes each
- Audience discussions: 20 minutes

Panel proposals where research papers will be presented must contain the following:

- The panel organizer must present an overview of the panel which should include:
 - Panel Title (maximum of 20 words)
 - Panel description or overview (no more than 300 words)
- Each presenter is required to provide the panel organizer with:
 - Presentation Title (maximum of 15 words)
 - Presentation Abstract (no more than 300 words)

Aside from the traditional paper presentations, we also highly encourage submission of other forms of panel proposals such as workshops, roundtable discussions, lectures,

colloquium, interactive sessions, or public fora. For these types of panels, flexibility in the guidelines will be extended but they must still strictly follow the conference theme.


