## Weeks 1-10 Road Check

Preparation for class involves reading/viewing all materials, taking notes so that you are ready to discuss related topics, and making connections with your prior learning and current practicum experiences. Complete Road Checks will address all questions thoughtfully, demonstrating reflective thinking and growth. Road Checks are due at the end of each week and include the following questions:

- Think about what you added or contributed to the discussion today. Consider both the small group discussions and the larger seminar group. Rate yourself between #1 (low) to #4 (high). Note: this is not used to determine any grade. Rather, it is a tool to assist you with developing skills in participating in seminar and other team-oriented discussions.
- 2. Now think about how well you listened, stayed attentive, responded and interacted with others. Consider both the small group discussions and the larger seminar group. Rate yourself between #1 (low) to #4 (high). Note: this is not used to determine any grade. Rather, it is a tool to assist you with developing skills in participating in seminar and other team-oriented discussions.
- 3. What one comment or conversation really got you thinking today? (what intrigued you, or gave you a new perspective, or made you want to know more?)
- 4. What do you wish that you had shared with the group or brought up today?
- 5. Any questions that you have? From the banal to the sublime.....what do you want to know more about?
