

REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLICATION DESIGN

1. Original materials of reports that have not been previously published are accepted for publication.
2. The volume of materials is up to 5 pages of A4 format, including tables and a list of references.
3. Text editor - Microsoft Word, file format - doc or docx, font Times New Roman; size - 14; line spacing - 1.5. Margins: 1.5 cm on all sides.
4. Header elements: first and last name (surname in caps) of the author(s), academic degree, academic title are indicated in the middle, followed by the name of the institution, city, e-mail, ORCID (if available) on a new line. The last name and first name of the author(s) should be bolded. The title of the material should be in capital letters, and the main text should be indented. At the end of the paper, a list of references should be provided in accordance with the international standard APA. References to the sources used should be given in the order of mention in the text.
5. The recommended structure of publications should contain logically presented material: keywords, introduction, purpose, results, conclusions, prospects for further research, conflict of interest. The following elements are allowed in the publication: images, graphs, diagrams (formatting: interval - 1.0; size - 12; table titles - in front, illustration titles - after, design - in regular Times New Roman font).
6. The authors are responsible for grammatical errors, the content of the text of publications, and the accuracy of scientific results.
7. The text is checked for plagiarism. Materials are rejected if plagiarism is detected. The materials are also rejected if the level of originality does not exceed 49%, or if the design of the materials does not meet the established requirements.
8. One author can submit no more than 2 publications and 2 reports.
9. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select materials in accordance with the conference topics and requirements for the design of materials.
10. It is forbidden to use authors from unfriendly countries: Russia, Iran, etc. in the list of references.
11. We kindly ask you not to use generative artificial intelligence tools to generate:

drawings or images, research results and conclusions, and the work itself. If the fact of using generative artificial intelligence tools is detected, the organizing committee has the right to reject the received materials.

12. Materials are accepted until May 01, 2024.
