- The Bible's fulfilled prophecies give evidence of its supernatural
- The Bible's unity, though 66 books written by approximately 40 different individuals on three continents over a period of 1500 years and in 3 languages, gives evidence to its supernatural and
- The Bible's historical accuracy, continuously reaffirmed through history and archeology, is evidence of its supernatural
- The Bible's endurance, despite burnings, bannings, and attempts to eradicate it, and its distribution as the most translated and read book in human history give evidence of its supernatural
