- Matched Play Guide.
- A copy (paper or digital) of this rules pack.
- A copy of your 700 point list (paper or digital)
- Measuring tape, dice, writing implements and a way to track your M/W/F/Ws!
- A set of 6 25mm Objective Markers.
- A tray or really useful box (Handy to save you packing and unpacking models all day.)
- An army! Please read the requirements below carefully!

Army Composition

Maximum 700 points!

Drake or Drake Slayer - See below!

Minimum 3 Models!

Models must be painted and based!

Drakes of Morgoth:

The winged Fire Drakes of Middle Earth were amongst Morgoth's greatest and most fearsome weapons. While all paled in the shadow of Anachalagon, each was still a terrible foe and equal to even the greatest heroes of the first age!

If you are playing with an 'Evil' army, you must include one 'Drake' in your army. The 'Drake' will use the "Dragon" profile found in Armies of Middle Earth, and you must pay the allotted points value for a Dragon and any upgrades from your 700pt limit when adding a 'Drake' to your army. The 'Drakes' faction and Race keywords become 'Drake'. They can not affect or be affected by any army bonuses or synergies.

In addition, the 'Drake' is an Independent Hero.

A Time of Heroes:

Many mighty heroes walked Middle Earth during the 1st age. But that's not to say only the greatest can perform great deeds...

As was proven in the events of the Hobbit, even the most unlikely folk may rise up and lay low the draconic servants of Morgoth!

If you are playing with a 'Good' army, you must include one 'Drake Slayer' in your army.

The 'Drake Slayer' uses the profile of Glorfindel on Asfaloth, but may swap their Elven Hand and a Half Blade with a Sword, Lance and Shield. Additionally, the 'Drake Slayer' gains the 'Hatred Drake' key word.

You must pay the allotted points value for the 'Drake Slayer' from your 700pt limit when adding

a 'Drake Slayer' to your army.

The 'Drake Slayers' faction and Race keywords become 'Drake Slayer'. They can not affect or be affected by any army bonuses or synergies.

Glorfindel and Asfaloth may be included in armies that are able to take them, in addition to your 'Drake Slayer'.

In addition, the 'Drake Slayer' is an Independent Hero.

Scenarios will be drawn at random from the new Matched Play Guide!

Scoring and Awards

Win - 3 Tournament Points

Draw - 2 Tournament Points

Loss - 1 Tournament Point

Tie breakers - Victory Point first, followed by Margin of Victory.

First round will be random pairings.

'Adjacent Pairings' will be used to match players for all following rounds.

Hobby awards: All work must be your own to enter the hobby awards. Armies that have previously won Best Army at a GBHL event will not be eligible to be entered into the Best Army Category. This is to encourage new entries from experienced painters, and to give newer hobbyists a chance to compete!
