#### **IB EXAM INFORMATION**

11th and 12th grade IB DP/CP Program and course students registered to test are DONE testing!! (Calendar here). Students can access published IB Exam scores on 06-Jul-2023 at 2:30 pm (all students received a printed copy of their pin code the week of April 24 and by email the week of spring break). It is highly recommended that students take a picture of their pin and save the paper copy in a visible location. Safari does not work, please use a different browser.

IB Exam fees (including any fee adjustments due to waivers or financial assistance requests) have been added to student accounts. If you have not paid for your IB exam, an **obligation** has been assigned.

# 2022-2023 End-of-Year MCPS SSL Information

Middle school and high school students should continue earning SSL hours towards their SSL graduation requirement by engaging in SSL opportunities during the 2022-2023 school year and over the summer, including traditional in-person opportunities and select virtual/remote opportunities that follow the guidelines posted on the MCPS SSL webpage (<a href="www.mcps-ssl.org">www.mcps-ssl.org</a>).

Please review the following important end-of-year information for the MCPS SSL program:

# Systemwide SSL Documentation Deadline

- · All SSL forms documenting service completed this school year must be submitted to schools' SSL coordinators by the systemwide required deadline of June 2, 2023.
- Any unsubmitted SSL forms for service completed since June 1, 2022, will be accepted until June 2, 2023.
- Please note that after June 2, 2023, SSL forms will no longer be accepted from the 2022-2023 school year or the summer prior.

The required systemwide deadline for submission of all SSL documentation is FRIDAY, June 2, 2023.

All SSL forms (MCPS Form 560-51: Student Service Learning Activity Verification form - <a href="https://bit.ly/SSLReflection">https://bit.ly/SSLReflection</a>) must be turned in to the school's SSL coordinator (<a href="https://bit.ly/SSLCoordinatorsMS">https://bit.ly/SSLCoordinatorsMS</a> or <a href="https://bit.ly/SSLCoordinatorsHS">https://bit.ly/SSLCoordinatorsHS</a>) by the <a href="mailto:systemwide">systemwide</a> required deadline of June 2, 2023, to be added to students' SSL records.

SSL forms for service completed during the 2022-2023 school year and the previous summer will NOT be accepted after June 2, 2023.

Summer is a wonderful time for students to engage in SSL opportunities and earn SSL hours towards meeting the 75-hour state graduation requirement!

To continue offering an array of SSL opportunities to students, MCPS will continue to allow nonprofit organizations and schools to host virtual/remote SSL opportunities for students!


