Exercise Name	2024 Clark County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) Hazardous Materials Full-Scale Exercise (FSE) .	
Exercise Date & Time	The Exercise will be conducted on Wednesday May 1, 2024. The exercise is scheduled to begin at 9:00 am and last no more than three hours and include a working lunch.	
Exercise Location	The FSE will be held at Clark County Fairgrounds , located at 4401 S Charleston Pike, Springfield, OH 45505 .	
Objectives	The FSE will focus on the State Emergency Response Commission objectives: #1 - Initial Notification #2 - Incident Assessment #3 - Incident Command #5 - Resource Management #6 - Communications #7 Response Personnel Safety #9 Emergency Public Information #10 - Traffic and Access Control	
Scenario & Threat	The FSE scenario will focus on a motor vehicle accident and hazardous materials release near South Charleston, Ohio. The exercise scenario will evolve with a simulated scene and life sized dummies serving in the roles of victims.	
Exercise Purpose	The primary objective of a hazardous materials full-scale exercise is to assess and enhance the preparedness, response capabilities, and coordination among emergency management personnel and stakeholders in effectively managing a hazardous materials incident. This exercise aims to simulate realistic scenarios, evaluate response procedures, and identify areas for improvement to ensure the safety of the community and minimize the impact of hazardous materials incidents.	
Hotwash	Following the exercise, the facilitator will conduct a hotwash session with all participants to gather their valuable input on the scenario, discuss follow-up items generated during the exercise, address any questions, and explore ideas for improvement.	
After Action Report	The After Action Report (AAR) is the culmination of the FSE. It will outline the strengths and areas for improvement identified during the exercise.
