What is the Group Conscience Meeting?	The AA Group Conscience is the collective voice of the members of an AA group, from any part of AA's service structure. The Group Conscience is a shared decision reached by a careful and respectful process where everyone has a voice, and everyone listens. The process is used whenever a considered decision is required. The goal is to reach a position of 'substantial unanimity'. This means that the decision made is one that all support or are prepared to accept.

1	Proposal: Updating the cost of Literature to match the COG purchased to sold	Al E/Vicki	What North Hall charges for books. When the Hall purchases literature from CCFAA we are charged tax at 8.75% currently. We are not selling literature at cost, we are selling under cost. Example – a Big Book cost \$15. Added tax this comes to \$16.31. When someone purchases a book we may not always have the correct change to give them. It would be an ideal situation to round the price to the nearest even dollar. We should consider changing the price of literature sold to include tax and rounded to the nearest dollar.
