<u>Water Report</u>: Josh presented the water report: there was 1 locate request, weed eating was done around the hydrants (thanks Josh), cards were sent out to the membership regarding a system flush to be done on Friday October 7th, and there are plans to install one more meter before the end of the season, weather permitting. Troy moved to accept the Water Report, Marguerite 2nd, passed by all.

Road Report: Steve has no road activity to report. Troy moved to accept the Road Report, Marcie 2nd, passed by all.

Old Business:

- -There was discussion about our need to take a map to Snohomish County showing the County road easement and our MREHA water line before we can proceed with the franchise agreement with County. John will go forward with this request.
- -There was policy discussion about the accessibility /maintenance need around individual homeowner's water meters, especially once the meters are being regularly read and monitored. It will likely be each homeowner's responsibility to clear the meter site, or they will be charged by MREHA to do it. This will be discussed at our January 2017 Annual Meeting.
- Thanks to Marguerite for contacting the State regarding our responsibility to pay B and O taxes. We were told that MREHA is not responsible to pay this type of tax.
