Recommended list of things to bring to WOAW Weekend 2026:

- Your excitement!!
- Snacks (if you want specific stuff!)
- Bug spray/tick repellent
- Comfortable clothes for playing outside
- Pajamas
- Layers/rainjackets in case of bad weather
- Linens, sleeping bag, towels, pillow & toiletries (if staying onsite)
- Water bottle*
- To-go mug for warm beverages (Help us be sustainable! We will have coffee and tea!)
- Swimwear if wanting to swim!
- Walking stick or trekking poles if desired
- Good Walking/Hiking shoes (+ sandals/shoes for relaxing)
- Shower shoes (flip flops, water shoes)
- Sun hat/baseball cap
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Camp chairs
- Ear plugs, eye masks, or anything needed for you to be comfy sleeping.
- Day pack
- Activities if we're stuck indoors (puzzles, art supplies, board/card games, musical instruments)
- Flashlight/headlamp

What to bring if you're participating in certain sessions:

- Disc golf discs (if you'd like to try the course! Though we will have some available)
- Personal Floatation Device/Life jacket (if you prefer to use your own!)
- Binoculars (for getting CLOSE and personal to birds)
- Hand lens or magnifying glass (for getting CLOSE and personal to plants)
- Favorite field guides (plants, birds, amphibians, etc.)
- Rite-In-The-Rain paper (you will be getting a small RITR notebook when you arrive!)
- Sketchbooks and any art supplies for enjoying plein air drawing
- Beverages/snacks to enjoy around a campfire
