McKinney-Vento Act's Homeless Education Program (NCLB: Title X)

Ensures that homeless children and youth are provided a free and appropriate public education despite the lack of a fixed, regular and adequate residence or a supervising parent or guardian.

Definitions

1. A fixed residence is permanent and not subject to change.
2. A regular residence is used consistently, as in nightly.
3. An adequate residence meets both the physical and psychological needs typically met in home environments.

Homeless Situations

Involve children and youth who:

- are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason;
- are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodations;
- are living in emergency or transitional shelters;
- are abandoned in hospitals;
- are awaiting foster care placement;
- have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings
- are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings; and
- Children and Youth in Homeless Families
- Unaccompanied Youth (Runaway, abandoned, and/or unsupervised youth)

Public School Rights

Homeless children and youth are entitled to immediate public school enrollment including attending classes and participating fully in school activities. Homeless children and youth are entitled to enrollment at their school of origin, provided it is in the best interest of the student, requested by parents and feasible. The school of origin is the school last attended by the homeless child or youth at the onset of homelessness.
