Zoom:

ACRES coaches use Zoom as the live video conferencing tool.

Benefits of Zoom:

- Many afterschool professionals are comfortable with Zoom
- Easier login for participants (no need for a Google account)
- Polling options

Google Docs

ACRES module documents are created in Google Docs, a free word processor.

Benefits of Google Docs:

- They are accessible across devices
- You can make a copy for yourself and then add in your notes as needed
