Weather:

We are praying for great weather and the vital areas of the event are completely covered and protected from rain including the performance area, equipment loading dock, warm-up room, directors lounge, judges area, and sound booth. Our intentions are to proceed forward with this competition as long as it is safe even if there is some rain just like any other professional event.

Equipment Trucks Loading & Unloading:

If you have a lot of equipment then we would prefer that you come Friday night before the event begins to unload. The loading dock is connected to the stage. Therefore, we must keep the loading dock quiet during performances. We have an incredible group of parents and students that will help you as needed but we must make sure that loading and unloading do not cause any disruptions or noise for the currently performing group.

We are not saying that it is impossible to load/unload during the event, but we are saying that if your load/unload process is deemed to be too noisy then you will be asked to pause until the currently performing group's performance is complete. There is ample parking space further away from the stage area for assembly, but we must keep the actual loading dock quiet during performances.

Homerooms

We are excited to welcome you to our upcoming show choir competition! While we are unable to provide dedicated homerooms, we are committed to ensuring you have the amenities you need for a smooth and enjoyable experience at the Brandon Amphitheater.

Changing Areas and Facilities:

We have designated two spacious restrooms exclusively for performers to use throughout the day for changing and other needs.

In addition, we are providing two 20x20 tents to serve as supplemental changing areas for your opening outfit preparations. One tent will be designated for male performers and one for female performers.

These tents will be available to your group 30 minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time to facilitate outfit changes. Please plan accordingly.

Storage Tents:

We will also provide multiple parent-donated tents where you may store personal items throughout the day. While these tents will offer convenience, you will be responsible for keeping track of your belongings.

Please note that Rankin County School District, Brandon High School, Brandon Show Choir, The City of Brandon, and any associated staff, faculty, parents, students, or volunteers are NOT responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items. We encourage you to take appropriate precautions to secure your valuables.

Our goal is to create a welcoming and memorable experience for all participants. We look forward to hosting you at the Brandon Amphitheater and can't wait to see your performances light up the stage!

Sound & Lighting

We are pleased to be using Big Noise Productions for this event. We will have 5 solo mics on mic stands across the front that may be moved as needed.

If you plan to bring a PA for your band please be prepared to provide a line out so that we can boost your band in the house PA if needed. The use of plugging your band in the house is up to you. You may have someone at the house mixing console helping us make that decision together so that your group(s) sounds their best.

Upon arrival, please proceed directly to the Amphitheater to check in at the registration desk. After signing the two waivers and completing the welcome and registration process, students will be directed to unload the bus and enter the Amphitheater. 'Fans' will be available to assist you and your students as you unload.




