Good Evening Lake Forest High School Families!

Tomorrow, Wednesday, November 16th, Lake Forest High School will host the PSAT School Day for all 9th-grade students. The PSAT9 is a state-mandated test and all 9th-grade students in Delaware are required to take the new, digital version of the PSAT.

10th and 11th-grade students will participate in an SAT practice test. These practice tests are full-length mock-ups of the SAT with the exact timing and breaks that the real tests will have in March. Juniors who took the PSAT/NMSQT in October will work on AP Classroom, Major Clarity, and Khan Academy SAT practice. All 9th, 10th & 11th Grade students were given their room assignments during enrichment on 11/15.

Students participating in 9th, 10th, or 11th-grade testing should not bring any additional electronic devices, such as cell phones and smartwatches, as they are not permitted in the testing room. Breakfast, snack, and lunch will be provided. Students may bring a water bottle and an additional snack.

The test will last 3-4 hours. Student devices must be turned off from 7:20 am until approximately 12:30 pm. Parents who need to contact their children during this time should contact the main office at 302-284-9291.

Seniors will participate in volunteer opportunities (pre-approved), or will be assigned work in Major Clarity, which is part of the state-required Student Success Plan.

When the tests are completed the students will participate in a PBS pep rally in the gymnasium.

Students must be present in school to participate in any after-school events.
