Yes. Eligible adults who are new to cannabis may purchase legal edibles from a licensed retailer. Beginners should read labels carefully, consider lower-THC options, and allow enough time for delayed effects.

Do You Carry CBD Edibles?

CBD gummies and other CBD edible products may be available depending on current inventory. Some CBD products also contain THC, so customers should review the complete cannabinoid information before purchasing.

Can I Order Cannabis Edibles Online?

Customers may be able to browse and order available edible products through the retailer's verified online menu. Pickup or delivery availability depends on current store services, location, inventory, and legal age verification.

What Identification Is Required?

Customers should bring valid government-issued photo identification that confirms their age and





identity. The retailer can refuse a purchase, pickup, or delivery when legal age cannot be verified.

How Should Cannabis Edibles Be Stored?

Products should remain sealed in their original child-resistant packaging and be kept in a cool, dry place when directed by the label. Store all edibles separately from ordinary food and securely away from children and pets.

Does Inventory Change Regularly?

Yes. New edible products may be added while other products sell out or become temporarily unavailable. The official online menu should provide the most current inventory information.

Why Should I Buy Edibles from a Licensed Retailer?

Licensed retailers sell products obtained through regulated supply channels and follow provincial age-verification requirements. Legal packaging provides standardized cannabinoid content, warnings, ingredients, and producer information that may be absent from unregulated products.
