

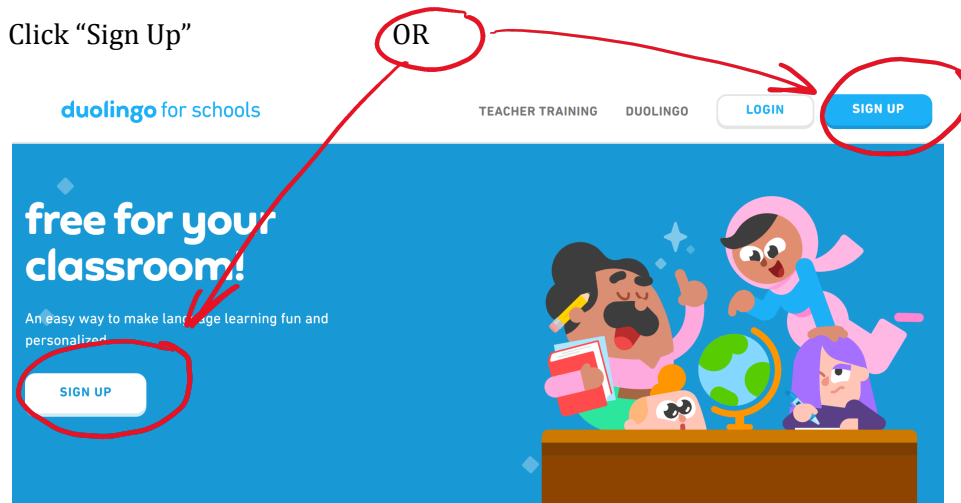
Duolingo for Schools Quickstart Guide

1. Step 1: Create a Duolingo for Schools Account

- Go to: <https://schools.duolingo.com>
- Click "Sign Up"



- On the next screen, click "Sign Up with Google"
(Once you complete this step, you can use your Google Account to log in by clicking the "log in" button)

Note: If using Duolingo for your own language practice, you must complete step 2 first, then skip Step 4.

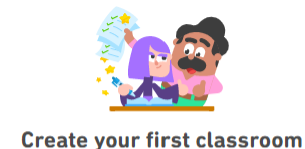

2. Step 2: Create a classroom on Duolingo for Schools

If you are new to Duolingo for Schools, you will be invited to **create your first class during the registration**



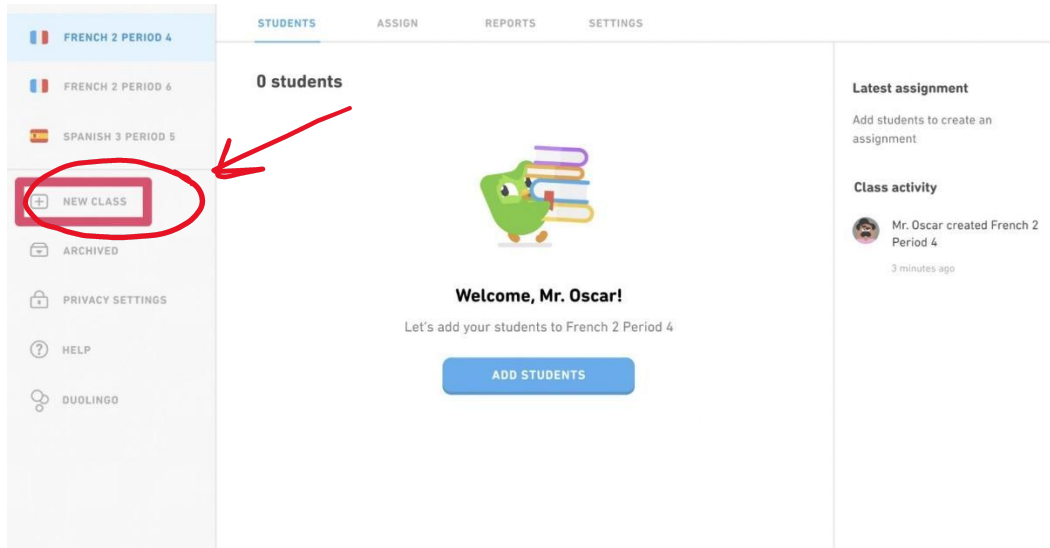

To Add additional classes, you'll follow a different process. From your teacher dashboard, select the "New Class" button located at the bottom of the sidebar on the left.



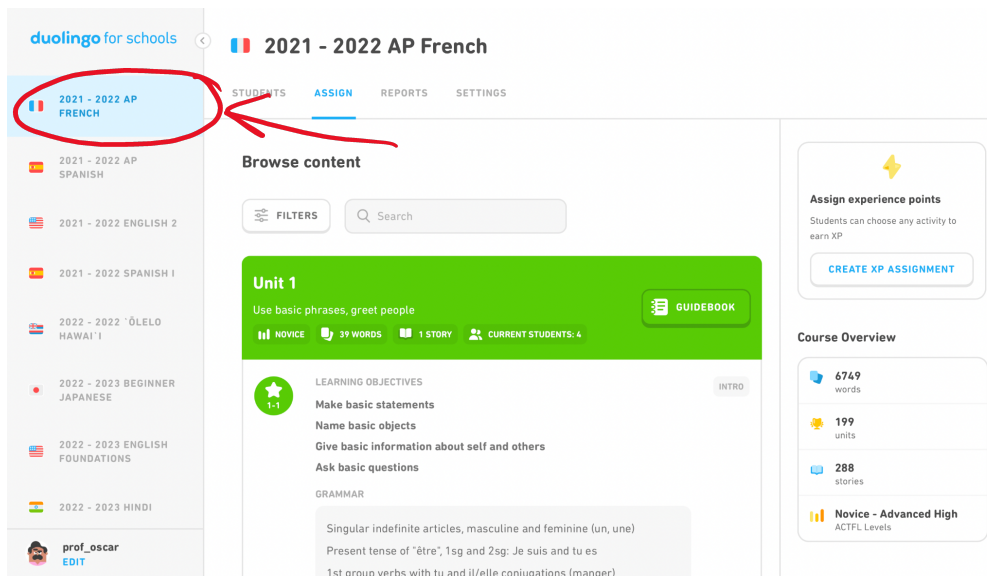
You will follow the same process to add an additional class.

By choosing "import from Google Classroom, you will not need to add students individually.

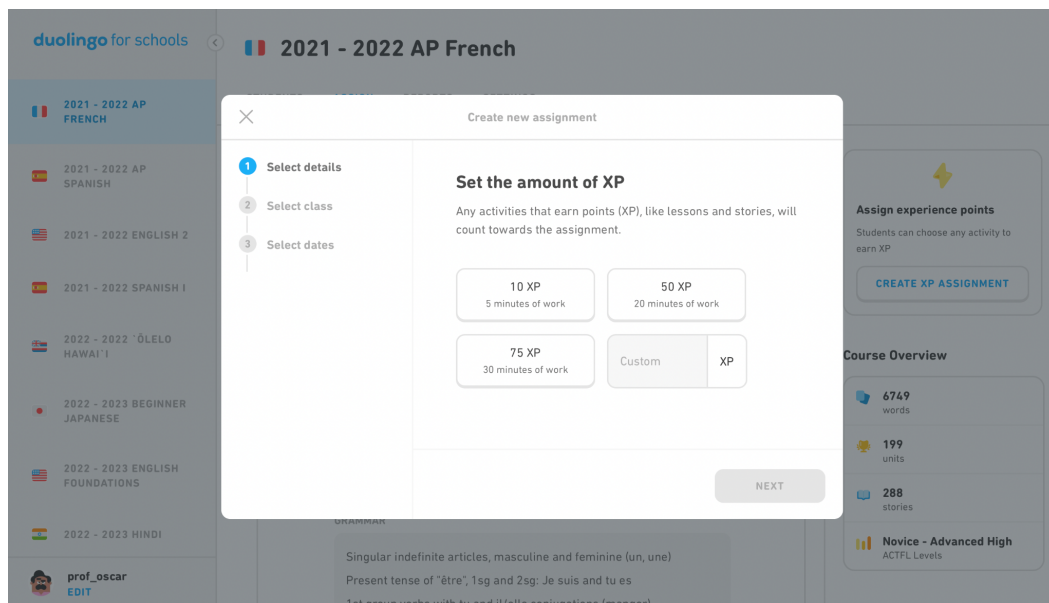
3. Step 3: Create an assignment in Duolingo classroom

- a. Begin by navigating to the teacher dashboard. Choose the class that you'd like to

create an assignment for on the left side of the screen.



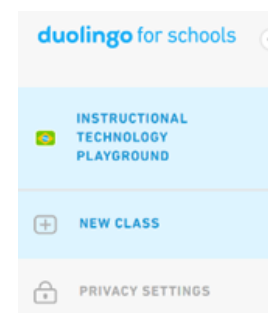
- b. From there, simply select “Create XP Assignment” on the right.
- c. Using the pop-up box that appears next, you can set the amount of XP, add classes to the assignment, and select the date students will begin working on it, as well as the deadline for the assignment.



- d. Select "Assign" for the final time to push the assignment to your students' accounts and post to Google Classroom.

Step 4: Use Duolingo to practice another language for yourself!

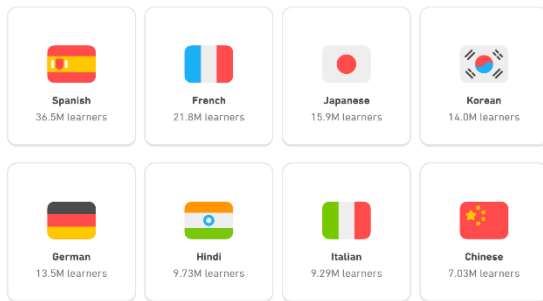
- a. One the left-hand side menu click “Duolingo” at the bottom.
