- 2026 Budget is 1.7 billion for next year's city, 40% public safety and sheriff, 7.5 million _____, 10.2 million homeness, TAB, eviction program, township Trustee Office
- Trash Service, 38th and meridian, east 38th Keystone, East 38th is public works to 46th street. If you have blue bins, they will be replaced by Lake Shore Recycling (LSR) Trash Service. This will happen in phases; only the blue trash bins will be replaced.
- Martindale and Brightwood Areas: Last meeting at Frederick Douglass Park proposed Data Center be built on 15 areas at 25th and Sherman Drive. Metro Block is the name of the tech company that wants to use AI and will be using our power Grid and the water. Brightwood area has old infrastructure. The AI Company needs to file a zoning change to build the center. There are fifty jobs coming but these jobs will be highly technical specialized positions out of state.
