

*After announcing a meet and greet picnic to kick off his speaking tour, Representative skiboy625 travels north to Duluth to meet with supporters and to rally for Lincoln Democratic candidates at the Park Point Recreation Area.*

Good afternoon Duluth!

Thank you all for being out here today. It really is a beautiful day out here and this really is an incredible area. We're right on the waters of the Superior Bay, just past those trees over there is the majestic and vast Lake Superior, and then right here we have a wonderful event that wouldn't have been possible without the help of our local volunteers. So let's give a quick round of applause to the people that made this possible!

*The crowd applauds towards the volunteers helping direct traffic and manning the stations, all of whom smile and wave with the recognition.*

So as many of you know, we have a pretty important election coming up here in Lincoln. It's that time of year where we go back to the ballot box and vote for our assembly members. This past term has been led nearly entirely by the Democrats down in Springfield, all helping significantly to better the state every day. Even after a rough start in the last state elections, OKBlackBelt moved up to the Governorship with Lt. Governor Baines joined him, and we have formed a strong and active group of hard working leaders who are doing their best to help not just all of you here today, but everyone else across this incredible state.

*Many in the crowd clap and cheer.*

If we look at the legislation proposed, it has been a nearly one-sided effort. Twenty-one bills on the state's docket out of twenty-eight bills this session were drafted by a Democrat. Yes you heard that right. Three quarters of the bills were written by the party that holds only a one seat advantage in the legislature, the second most seats in the house, and only two seats in the senate. It doesn't matter how we're doing as a whole, we're still out here doing our jobs!

Now let's look at some examples of the hard work being done. IGotzDaMastaPlan introduced a wonderful bill called the [LINCOLNRides Act](#), which would allow people in need to have access to free mass transit anywhere in the whole state, helping to reduce emissions, lower congestion, and helping low income individuals have access to transportation to access their places of work or services that they need. IGotz has also introduced [another incredible bill revolving around mass transit](#) in the state; appropriating funds and establishing a committee to begin the construction of a new rail line going through St. Louis, helping to further connect the people of the city while simultaneously reducing congestion and emissions.

*The crowd claps, acknowledging the success and work of IGotzDaMastaPlan.*

Let's keep going down the list of our active assembly members. Murpple. Murpple has been a huge advocate for the expansion of infrastructure in the state. From finding new ways to raise revenue or reduce costs, to advocating for the expansion of the state's rail assets through... the Train Force!

*The crowd cheers and applauds enthusiastically, many begin chanting Train Force repeatedly.*

While it may not be the first idea on anyone's mind, Murpple thought of the incredible idea to attempt to find and relocate trains from our neighbors in Sierra to our railways here in Lincoln. I understand some have criticized the assembly member's thinking, but ingenuity and creativity for solving valid issues is truly what we need in Lincoln.

*Again the crowd cheers loudly, with chants of Train Force breaking out.*

Next, assembly member LakshyGB. Lakshy while coming into a seat for the first time has shown a strong work ethic and commitment to this state so far. From introducing [legislation](#) that clarifies and expands how law enforcement should take action to save an animal, to [lessening the harshness of the state's eviction laws](#), to [allowing abused minors over fifteen to get an abortion](#), Lakshy has already shown a strong work ethic and a mind for reform in a county and state that so desperately need it. While it still may be early in Lakshy's career, I am already very impressed and am excited to see what ideas and work come next.

*The crowd applauds again.*

While those I just mentioned are running for reelection, there are still several more Democrats hoping to come into Lincoln to serve you all here. Cubascastrodistrict has already kicked off the Democratic campaigning efforts down in Chicago, [meeting and holding a rally with education leaders](#) from around the state showing off the necessity for change and education reform in the state. We also have Warren4560 who I've talked to in recent days who has begun planning campaigning efforts, and so far I see a lot of promise and have very strong hopes for Warren and his campaign through the coming days.

So, everyone, after all of this hard work, do you want to keep the ball rolling in the assembly or should we squander that effort?

*The crowd yells "keep the ball rolling!" in unison.*
