While it is understandable that training and competition can and will breed excitement and high emotion, the ASC believes that spirited training and competition can be experienced without a “win at all cost” mentality.

Being a member of ASC is an earned privilege and an honor, and with this comes responsibility. In all aspects of training and competition, we are ambassadors for ASC and the sport of ski racing, freeride, ski cross and recreational skiing.

The ASC Code of Conduct is designed to:

1. Ensure the safety and well-being of every participant.
2. Respect that all participants have the right to participate in the best program possible without interference from the inappropriate behavior of others.
3. Promote a positive public perception of ASC and its sponsors.

Infractions of the Codes of Conduct by any member of the club will be subject to disciplinary action. This may include the immediate suspension from all club activities by the supervising coach until the ASC Board of Directors and/or Disciplinary Committee reviews and decides upon the matter. The coach has the discretion to decide when an athlete may or may not train or race until such time that the ASC Disciplinary Committee is able to convene.
