Adrielle "Bow" Belle is a self-proclaimed "Pop Punk Princess," and award-winning singer/songwriter out of Spanish Harlem, in New York City. Some of her most notable songs include the International Songwriting Award Recipient and debut single, 'Runaway' (Prod. by Mantra) as well as the critically acclaimed track 'Falling' (Prod. By Feelo) off of her Visual E.P., 'Nightlight.'

Music helped Bow Belle to find her voice, after it was silenced through the turbulence of surviving a physically abusive home, later wearying the foster care system and eventually becoming a homeless teen-runaway. Her music is, as she states: A "testament to all of those who have had to somehow 'light their own way,' when all they could see was darkness." She hopes that her songs can become an anthem of hope for all of the survivors, freaks, and 'problem-children," of the world.

"I'm a Valentine's Baby, and every song I write is my gift to you: I wrap it up in a "pretty bow," add some spikes and chains for all of the "troubled youth," and make it with lots of love, for anyone who could use a little more."
