## EASTON VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT NORTHEAST SEPARATION RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the Easton Valley School District has agreed to pay a litigation settlement fee in the amount of \$450,000 to the Northeast School District regarding the breach of contract for East Central's whole grade sharing initiative;

**WHEREAS**, the Easton Valley School District is not required to participate in events with the Northeast School District since Easton Valley is a member of the Tri Rivers Conference and Northeast is a member of the River Valley Conference;

**WHEREAS**, the Easton Valley School District desires to end competition with the Northeast School District for a period of five years until relations can be improved between the school districts;

**THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the Easton Valley Community School District Board of Education hereby establishes the following provisions for the Easton Valley Athletic and Fine Arts programs through the 2019-2020 school year.

## **Provisions:**

- 1. Easton Valley will not schedule athletic/fine arts events with the Northeast Community School District in grades 7-12 in an association approved sport/fine arts event.
- 2. Easton Valley will not participate in athletic or fine art events hosted by the Northeast Community School District.
- 3. Easton Valley will not invite the Northeast Community School District to participate in tournaments, invitationals, or multiple team events in grades 7-12 in an association approved sport or fine arts competition.
- 4. Easton Valley will continue to compete against Northeast Community School District teams when authorized by the IAHSAA/IGHSAU (post season tournaments, district football, etc)
- 5. Easton Valley will continue to compete at away team tournaments that include both Easton Valley and Northeast School District.
- 6. Easton Valley will not consider sharing athletics with Northeast in any sport or club team.
