SELECTORS REPORT

PENNANT PLAYERS- It would be helpful if you could let Shirley know ahead of time of any dates when you will be unavailable to play.

A few points of bowls etiquette as we launch into the pennant season:

- 1. It is the second's responsibility to introduce team members at the beginning of the game.
- 2. Do not follow your bowl sideways, thereby encroaching on the rink next to you. Stay within your rink when crossing from the mat end to the other end.
- 3. Acknowledge your opponent's good shot.
- 4. Do not complain when luck goes with your opponent or against your team.

We hope you have an enjoyable and successful pennant season – never forget that your are representing **your** Club.

To those of you who are not playing pennants, keep coming on Tuesdays, remember there is a special trophy for the social player who earns the most points during the pennant season. You receive 5 points just for playing and an extra 2 points if your team wins.

UMPIRES CORNER

Possession of the rink will belong to the player or team whose bowl is being played.

As soon as each bowl comes to rest, possession of the rink will transfer to the opposing player or team after allowing time for marking a toucher as soon as it comes to rest.

A player should not deliver a bowl until the previous bowl comes to rest.
