MUSIC PACKING LIST:

Assigned chamber sheet music
Other sheet music
Sturdy folder to keep music in
Pencils and pens
Rosin (for string players)
1 non-phone metronome
1 folding music stand (optional)
1 full extra set of strings (if possible)

String Players: Please ensure you come to camp with your instrument and bow in good shape! It can be very humid during the summer at camp, which may affect your instrument or bow.

BEDDING***:**

- Sheets (xlong) - 30" X 74"
 - 1 Pillow and pillowcase
 - Warm blankets and/or sleeping bag
 - 2-3 Towels, one for beach use
- For campers traveling by plane, PCP will provide bedding and towels to reduce baggage.

CONCERT DRESS - Please bring one full outfit of a combination of the following:

Dress shirt

Dress pants or skirt or dress

Dress clothing can be any color

*Please make sure your skirt/dress is **below the knees** and if you are a cellist you are able to play cello in it! Remember you will be on a stage at eye level with the audience.*

CLOTHING:

1-2 Bathing suits

1 Pair warm weather pajamas

1 Pair cold weather pajamas

2 Long sleeved, warm shirts

2-3 Sweaters/Sweatshirts

1 Warm, cozy jacket

Rain Jacket/Rainwear

8 T-shirt/Short sleeved shirts

2-3 Pairs of shorts

2-3 Pants/Jeans

10 Sets underwear

10 Pairs socks

1 Pair of sneakers

1 Pair of shoes you can hike in

Optional: 1 pair of water shoes or shower shoes



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Recommended Baggage:

Cabin space is limited. A closable box or suitcase that can be easily accessed and organized is best. A laundry basket for music belongings and footwear is very helpful. The luggage should be 19' high maximum to fit under the bunks.

We will need to work together at camp to take extra care that we are keeping our belongings compact and organized. Think about what you need to label (for example, toothpaste, sunscreen, bug spray, etc). Please keep this in mind when packing and planning for camp!

Try to pack layers of clothing thereby being prepared for hot or cold weather. Vermont can be chilly in the morning or at night. Long sleeves and long pants are good protection against mosquitoes.

Laundry:

We will have a laundry service on the **second Monday** of each session. Please bring payment in the form of a check/cash **at the end of the session**. Checks should be made payable to 'Point CounterPoint'.

PCP Swag:

Campers will be able to pick out various types of SWAG for sale while at camp.

Please bring payment in the form of a check or exact cash at check-in on Sunday pick-up to cover the order. Checks should be made payable to 'Point CounterPoint'.

Notes:

- * Medication should exactly correlate to what you have told us on the medical form.
- ** Please make sure the water bottles are clearly labeled with the camper's name. The bigger the bottle the better! A bigger water bottle means less time spent waiting in line to fill it up and more time for activities!
- *** Have one personal sanitizer to keep in your instrument case and one to keep on your person.
- **** **We are 100% unplugged at camp.** No electronics are permissible at camp.

*******If you are flying and do not have the space to pack bedding, PCP can provide this for you for \$25. Just request this ahead of time via email, please.**
