Scout Registration Guide

Cost:

Registration Fee: Transfer Fee for Webelos Free, Brand New Scouts \$33

Troop 711 B&G re-registers every year in January. Future registration is covered by the Troop through dues.

- Dues: \$250.00 (sibling discounts available, Sept. Recruitment night \$62.50 for the rest of the year)
 - Dues are used to cover the base costs of food and equipment for campouts
 - advancement and award materials
 - annual re-chartering fees
 - registration fees.
 - It is also used to pay for any camping/entrance/parking fees associated with campouts or special events. Dues are paid by the end of January each year).
 - Includes items such as Scout Handbook, Troop 711 neckerchief, slide, Troop 711 patch, green shoulder tabs
- Required Scout Items: Depends on what you need. See Pricing Worksheet

Uniforms:

- Weekly meeting dress protocol varies through the year but generally Class A's are worn to the first meeting of the month.
- Class A: Purchased By Family
 - Required for all troop members. This includes the khaki shirt with patches and insignia properly displayed (see Scout Handbook), Troop neckerchief, slide, slacks or shorts (First-Class and above), Scout belt and socks.
 - Scouts are required to wear a proper Class A uniform at all weekly meetings, Boards of Review, and Courts of Honor.
- Class B: \$12 (offered for purchase annually)
 - Required for all troop members. Class B T-shirts are typically worn during outdoor events.
 - Class B's are worn at Summer Camp during much of the day. It is recommended that a Scout going to Summer Camp have 2 Class B shirts.



Scoutbook:

- Scoutbook is the online database for our troop. Each parent should have an account so that they may track their scouts progress, and find POCs in the troop.

Forms:

- Youth Application - All Webelos are required to fill out an youth application to transfer to Boy Scouts.
- BSA Health and Medical Record – This information is kept on file and is carried on all outings to facilitate emergency care and contact. Part A and B are required for all activities, Part C required for activities over 72 hours. Required for all registered Scouts and Adults.
- Adult Application – We encourage at least each parent to participate in Troop 711. Examples include: Assistant Scoutmaster, Committee Member and Merit Badge Counselor.
- You need to complete Youth Protection Training and a registration application.
- Vehicle Information Sheet – For insurance purposes, the Troop must maintain information on all vehicles which may be used to transport Scouts.
