Objectives of Activity:

A visit to BSE provides students with a practical understanding of how the stock market operates. It allows them to witness real-time trading activities, understand the functioning of stock exchanges, and gain insights into the dynamics of financial markets.

- To offer unique learning opportunities beyond the classroom
- provide students with practical exposure to the real working environment of industries
- To gain insights into the Financial Market.
- To know about the Master Class in Data Science conducted by BSE.

Description of Activity :

The Department of Banking & Insurance and BBI Students Association- Genius Guild Club had organised an Industrial Visit to **Bombay Stock Exchange, Fort, Mumbai** on **Wednesday, 18th December 2024**. **31** students participated in the visit. The resource person was **Mr. Yogesh Patil**. He briefed the students about the role & Functions of BSE and opportunities in Data Sciences.

The day began with an introduction to the history and significance of the Bombay Stock Exchange, highlighting its pivotal role in the Indian financial system. Students were then divided into smaller groups, each accompanied by a guide well-versed in the intricacies of stock trading, market analysis, and technology integration in financial systems.

- **Market Observation:** Students observed live trading sessions on the BSE floor, witnessing the hustle and bustle of stock traders, brokers, and market participants. This provided them with a first hand view of how buy and sell orders is executed, and the rapid pace at which financial transactions takes place.
- **Interactive Sessions:** The visit included interactive sessions with experienced professionals from the finance and technology sectors. Students had the opportunity to ask questions, discuss market trends, and gain insights into career paths within the industry. These sessions aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical applications.
- **Technology Showcase:** BBI students explored the technological infrastructure supporting stock trading platforms. They learned about the role of information technology in ensuring seamless transactions, data security measures, and the use of analytics for market research.

The main purpose of the visit was to give children opportunities for learning outside of the classroom and gain practical experience in the real working environment of industries. Students can relate their theoretical knowledge gained in BBI courses to real-world scenarios. Seeing concepts like stock trading, market indices, and financial instruments in action can enhance their understanding and make the subject matter more tangible.
