- Drawing conclusions
- Finding clues to get some answers
- Adding those clues to what we already know or have read
- There can be more than one correct answer
- We need to be able to support inferences

KIS: Key Words, Infer, Support

- •This mnemonic strategy helps students remember the three steps in making and supporting inferences.
 - Key words and facts from the text are identified
 - Inferences are made using the keywords/facts and background/prior knowledge
 - Supporting details are accessed using prior/background knowledge
