Bible – Unit 11 Test Study Sheet

The Divided Kingdom (1 Kings 11-16; 2 Chronicles 13-16)

Some of the people to know for this test:

Ahijah: He ripped up his robe and gave 10 pieces to Jeroboam as a sign that Jeroboam would get to be king over 10 of the tribes of Israel.

Rehoboam: He told the people of Israel he would tax them even *more* than his father Solomon had done.

Jeroboam: He was the first king over the divided kingdom of Israel. He set up golden calves for the people to worship at Dan and Bethel in Israel so that the Israelites wouldn't have to go into Judah to worship at the temple in Jerusalem.

Asa: He was a good king, but at the end of his life he began to trust in human ability more than in God and he developed a disease in his foot.

Ahab: He was the most wicked king of all who provoked God to anger. Ahab was influenced by his wife Jezebel who introduced the worship of Baal into Israel.

- Be prepared to describe a way you can be a *positive* influence for others.
- Israel broke many of God's commandments during this time including the following:
 - "You shall have no other gods before me." (Exodus 20:3)—They served idols and worshiped Baal.
 - "You shall not make for yourself an idol." (Exodus 20:4)—Jeroboam made golden calves for the Israelites to worship.
