Requesting Permission to Speak

- Builds effective listening skills.
- Curbs impulses and allows cadets to think before speaking.

Requesting permission to "Carry On"

- Acknowledges and demonstrates respect for authority figures.
- Prepares for participation in real-world superior/subordinate relationships such as teacher/pupil, employer/employee, or coach/athlete, based on mutual respect.
- Cultivates awareness of the immediate environment and tasks underway.

Position of Attention and Military Courtesies

- Develops control over mind and body in a variety of environments and conditions.
- Promotes disciplined engagement with immediate surroundings, peers, and supervisors.

Marching

- Instills teamwork, attention to detail, situational awareness, self discipline, and evaluating one's own desires in favor of the needs of the group.
- Builds self-confidence and mastery.

Calling Cadence

- Builds camaraderie, teamwork, esprit de corps, and willingness to contribute to a team effort and celebrate success.
- Promotes pride in the group and respect for fellow teammates contributing to a joint effort.

Not Talking in Formation

Strengthens impulse control, and the ability to internally identify and manage various emotions.

Dining Room Procedures

- Places personal responsibility and accountability on the cadet as they continue to develop a willingness to comply with rules and directives.
- Builds awareness of diet as a component of a healthy lifestyle.

Counting Off

Develops cadet's ability to prepare for and anticipate upcoming tasks.

Physical Training

- Increases feelings of confidence and well-being through the release of endorphins and general stress reduction.
- Builds resilience and grit through fitness.

Obstacle/Confidence Courses, Rappelling and Other Adventure Training

- Breaks down false psychological limits that cadets may have set for themselves.
- Builds confidence.

Inspections-Personal and Living Area

Demonstrates attention to details, and outward expressions of personal orderliness, organization, and discipline.

Polishing Boots and Uniform Maintenance

Expresses pride in personal appearance.

Symbolizes strong attention to detail, and readiness to participate maturely in professional settings.

Classroom Procedures

Cultivates self-discipline, concentration, and completion of higher-order learning activities.
