Examen final: semestre uno español 3-4 2016-2017

- ☐ The final exam will be worth **100 points** total; there will be no oral component this semester. The exam consists of **three parts**:
 - 1. Multiple choice questions
 - 2. Reading comprehension questions: You will read some short selections in Spanish and then answer questions related to the reading.
 - Writing prompt: You will be given three choices of prompts and you will choose ONE to answer in about 45-50 words.
- The multiple choice part of the exam will cover the topics listed **BELOW** from chapters 7-8 in your green texto "Aventura" (online version) as well as the topics covered in your APUNTES de la clase. Please note that the topics are in **DESCENDING ORDER OF IMPORTANCE** on the exam. This means that there will be many more questions regarding "pretérito -AR" than the concept of "-dor/-ista." This may be useful to you in prioritizing how much time to spend studying each topic.
 - 1. <u>pretérito –AR</u>: p. 334 (only regular -AR verbs in pretérito will be on the final exam + -CAR/-GAR/-ZAR verbs in the pretérito)
 - 2. <u>Direct object pronouns: p.284 + where they go in the sentence</u>
 - 3. <u>Indirect object pronouns</u> + "<u>verbs like gustar"</u>: p.323 (you also DO need to know the meaning of all of the "verbos como gustar" from the <u>list</u>).
 - 4. presente progresivo (-ando/-iendo): p.282
 - 5. <u>using presente progresivo + DOPs:</u> p.285
 - 6. <u>verbos with irregular "yo" forms in the present (apuntes pt. l y pt. ll</u>): p. 296 (*ALL verbs from the "Irregular Yo's" song may be on the final).
 - 7. <u>stem changing verbs **o-ue / u-ue:**</u> p. 274 (poder, costar, recordar, volver, jugar, dormir)
 - 8. Ordinal numbers (first, second, third, etc.): p.304
 - 9. -dor/-ista: p.302
- □ The exam will also cover all vocab from the Aventura 1 textbook chapters: ch. 7A (p.289), 7B (weather, p.309), 8A (p.337), & 8B (p.355). You may also find all that vocabulary on Conjuguemos.
- ☐ You will also be responsible for knowing all of the vocabulary found on all of the

conjuguemos activities listed under the "Student Zone"; though some vocabulary will be in a distinct "section," much of it you will simply need to know in the context of the questions on the test. You can print **new copies** of any vocab on www.conjuguemos.com; log-in and on the main page you see when you log in ("Student Zone"), **click on the activity** that has the words you need (for example "Aventura 1: 7B") and then under "**Printables/Reference**," click "Vocabulary List." ***REMEMBER:** ALL VOCABULARY IN ANY ACTIVITIES FOUND IN THE STUDENT ZONE MAY APPEAR ANYWHERE ON THE FINAL EXAM.

- □ Parte Escrita: You will need to write 45-50 words about <u>one</u> of the following topics. A good way to prep would be to practice your present tense verb endings + the vocabulary associated with the topic (for example on conjuguemos):
- Ordinal numbers (First, second, third, etc.; you could write about any topic in the present tense and would need to use a minimum number of "ordinal numbers.")
- Los quehaceres (chores)
- Tus pasatiempos favoritos (your favorite past times) and/or your likes and dislikes
- What people in the class (or your family, or any other group) are doing right now, at the moment (using the presente progresivo)
