Double Decker Draft

Double Decker is a draft format for four players.

The Draft

- 1. Seat each player randomly with six boosters each.
- 2. Players open one booster each, pick two cards from it, and pass the rest to the left, repeat until all the cards in the booster are drafted
- 3. Repeat with the other five boosters, alternating between passing left and right
- 4. Players build two 40-card decks from their drafted cards and basic lands

The Play

- 1. Players play against the opponent they drafted across from
- 2. Play a four-game round robin of all possible matchups until one player wins three: A vs. X, B vs. Y, A vs. Y, B vs. X
- If the result is a 2-2 tie, players choose which of the two opposing decks they play against in the fifth and deciding game (this choice is hidden and revealed simultaneously)
- 4. Winners play winners and losers play losers in round two

Notes

- You can devise any tournament structure you'd like for four players with two decks each. The suggestion above operates like a best three-of-five and covers all the matchups, but here are other knobs you have on tournament length:
 - Incorporate best-of-three matches between the decks instead of single-games (sideboard cards belong to one deck or the other, not both)
 - Instead of playing all four matchups and a fifth decider, shorten it to "A vs. X, B vs. Y, choose decks for game three"
 - Optional third round: complete the round robin and play everyone
 - You could skip tiebreaker games in this structure and see if there is a player with the best overall record after the twelve games, then tiebreaker from there as needed
- This format works with any boosters that would work for a normal draft, but if you do a
 chaos draft, I suggest having players draft their six boosters out of the 24 before drafting
 the cards in the boosters themselves
- I haven't tried this with Cube yet, but that's next on the list
