Dear Students and Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2028,

On Tuesday, December 9, 2025, all Foley High School 10th graders will have the opportunity to take the PreACT assessment. This exam is directly aligned with the ACT and gives students an early opportunity to explore career interests and plan for their future educational goals.

The PreACT provides valuable feedback for course selection, identifies academic strengths and areas for improvement, and helps guide discussions about college and career readiness. It also serves as meaningful practice for the ACT—the college entrance exam commonly used for admission and scholarship consideration.

The PreACT helps students:

- Demonstrate college and career readiness skills
- Gain practical experience before taking the ACT
- Identify strengths and areas needing improvement

The exam will be administered to all sophomores on the morning of December 9 in assigned classrooms. Please avoid scheduling appointments that morning so your student can participate. The test takes approximately three hours.

Students may use certain approved calculators on the Mathematics section. Most calculators used at Foley High School are acceptable. You can review the [ACT Calculator Policy](#) online for a full list of approved devices. If a student does not have an approved calculator, an electronic calculator will be available through the testing platform.

ACT, Inc. offers free [online practice tests](#) and prep resources. These tools allow students to review their results and access personalized resources to strengthen their skills.

After score reports are received, additional information will be shared on how to interpret your student's PreACT Student Report and understand the results.

We encourage students to begin planning early in high school for success in college and beyond. The PreACT is one of several valuable resources that can support this journey. For more details, you can read "[Why Take the PreACT.](#)"
