### Criteria For Scholarship

- Applicant must be a graduate, or eligible for graduation in 2024, of one of the following high schools: Alta-Aurelia, Newell-Fonda, Ridgeview, Sioux Central, Storm Lake Public, or Storm Lake St. Mary's.
- Applicant must be attending a trade school, community college or 4 year college no later than September 30, 2024.
- Applicant must have achieved a GPA of 2.5 or greater during their last academic year.
