



Kimberley Nordic Club (KNC) Biathlon Range Opening and Closing Procedure

About: This document provides a step-by-step process to successfully open and close the KNC Biathlon Range.

At the KNC Stadium

1. Greet the Welcome Centre attendant and inform of the day's range activities.
2. If renting the range, the biathlon warming hut key can be signed in and out from the Welcome Centre attendant for each rental day.
3. Obtain the "Shooting in Progress" sign and display by the entrance of the KNC stadium area.

At the Range-Stadium

4. If cold enough, start the wood stove fire in the warming hut.
5. Attach Red/Green flags to each post on either side of the range. While setting up the range ensure the green flags are up.
6. Position "Shooting in Progress" signs at either ends of the biathlon stadium area. The "Spectators Welcome" sign is positioned at the bottom of the hill at 5 Corners juncture.
7. If needed, shovel out the firing line and position lane numbers at appropriate lane locations.
8. Position mats/rifle rests at required shooting lane.

At the Range-Down Range

9. Shovel out targets and area surrounding targets if needed.
10. Assess targets for proper functioning and adjust accordingly.
11. White/black paint to targets as needed.

12. Staple paper targets as needed.

13. Pull yellow target lane ropes from targets to the left of shooting mat.

At the Range-Stadium

14. Position Ammunition Loading table by shooting platform.

15. Position one to two scopes/tripods by the shooting platform.

16. Position rifle rack by shooting platform.

17. Position rifles on the rifle rack with trigger locks in place until ready to shoot.

18. To open the range-pull the red flags.
