

Adjectives and Adverbs

Adjectives modify or describe a noun or pronoun. Adjectives often add description.

The *fast* runner.

The *valuable* car.

Adverbs modify or qualify a verb. Adverbs often answer: When? Where? Why? How? Under what conditions?

Read this book *first*.
