

GoogleDocs:

Paste a link to you document (it can be blank) **by Saturday April 28th, at midnight**. To link your document and make it accessible, follow the instructions below:

- (1) CREATE a new googledoc (go to drive.google.com, login, press "new" at top right corner)
- (2) Once you're on the new googledoc, CLICK "SHARE" at the top right corner;
- (3) select "GET SHAREABLE LINK";
- (4) Select "ANYONE WITH LINK CAN EDIT" on the drop-down menu;
- (5) COPY AND PASTE YOUR LINK next to your name on the spreadsheet.

Draft Workshop:

On Monday, April 30th, your document should contain the full draft (5 page minimum). Then, you have **from 9:30am until midnight** to respond to TWO DRAFTS in your group. To complete the draft workshop, follow the instructions below:

1. Select one person's paper in your group (the person DIRECTLY BELOW your name), and click on the link next to their name. Read the first paper in full, then answer the following questions, using the comment function when necessary:
 - a. Argument/Thesis
 - i. Is the thesis specific and debateable? Are the terms well defined (not vague?). Does it address a theme in the novel? If not, make a comment.
 - b. Organization -- Topic Sentences
 - i. What is the main point in each paragraph? Write the main point as a comment in the topic sentence.
2. Select the NEXT PAPER below your name, read it in full, and answer the following question, using the comment function when necessary.
 - a. Paragraph organization -- Structure
 - i. Check for C E A method (Claims, Evidence, Analysis) in each paragraph. Point out the sections where this information is missing or can be enhanced by using the comment function.
