To participate you need to..

- be currently In Year 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, or 12.
- follow the same curriculum as most other students in your year.
- be deaf (all levels of hearing loss) **or** vision impaired.
- be hearing/seeing with a deaf/vision impaired sibling
- attend a mainstream school (including maintained secondary schools with a deaf/vision impaired unit, academies, or independent schools) in England.
